REQUEST FOR VOLUNTARY SUSPENSION OF TRADING IN LMW SECURITIES

Pursuant to ASX Listing Rule 17.2, LandMark White Limited (**LMW**) hereby requests a suspension of trading in its securities with immediate effect pending a further announcement in relation to the data incident (the **Incident**) originally announced 5th February 2019.

As a result of the Incident, LMW has been suspended from receiving work from a significant number of our clients which is impacting our revenues, profitability and cashflows.

At this point in time we are unable to ascertain when these clients will reinstate LMW and hence when LMW will be in a position to assess with any certainty the financial impact of the Incident.

In addition, LMW anticipates that continued public commentary does not allow for an informed market for trading in LMW securities.

LMW expects that it would be able to provide the market with accurate information relating to the financial impact of the Incident and hence a forecast for FY2019 within the next two to four weeks and lift the suspension at that time.

The Company is not aware of any reason why the voluntary suspension should not be granted.
