Acusensus secures mobile phone detection contract in South Australia

Highlights

- New five-plus year contract with the South Australian Government for provision of fixed mobile phone detection camera installations using Acusensus 'Heads-Up' solutions
- Seventh major multi-year service contract for Acusensus
- Estimated total contract value over the initial term of approximately \$5m (excluding GST)

Acusensus Limited (ASX:ACE) (Acusensus), a technology company designing and developing artificial intelligence enabled road safety solutions, is pleased to announce that Acusensus Australia Pty Ltd, a wholly owned subsidiary of Acusensus, has entered into a new agreement with the South Australian Government to deliver multiple fixed mobile phone detection camera installations (Agreement). The signing of the Agreement sees half of Australia's states and territories using Acusensus technology for mobile phone enforcement.

The Agreement is for a five-year term, with an option for an additional one year. Acusensus will supply, install and operate fixed site mobile phone detection camera solutions that detect drivers who are using mobile phones whilst driving. The South Australian Government may terminate the Agreement upon thirty days' written notice, but only after the second anniversary of the Agreement has passed.

The estimated total contract value over the initial five-year term of the Agreement is approximately \$5m (excluding GST). The staged rollout of the services is expected to commence from April 2024.

This Agreement is Acusensus' seventh multi-year enforcement contract and sees half of Australia's states and territories now using Acusensus' innovative technology to address distracted driving. This new program in South Australia builds upon Acusensus' existing programs in New South Wales, Queensland and the Australian Capital Territory.

Acusensus Founder and Managing Director, Alexander Jannink, said the award of this new contract in South Australia demonstrates Acusensus' commitment to delivering road safety improvements on Australian roads.

"We are very pleased to be bringing life-saving enforcement technology to South Australian roads and to be working with the South Australian Government. After pioneering mobile phone and seatbelt enforcement, I am particularly pleased that Australian jurisdictions have embraced the adoption of these new behaviour change programs such that Acusensus is now supplying ongoing programs to half of the Australian jurisdictions.
