VanEck Global Clean Energy ETF aims to provide investment returns, before fees and other costs that track the performance of the S&P Global Clean Energy Select Index (**Reference Index**) licensed from S&P Dow Jones Indices LLC (**SPDJI**).

Effective market open on 18 October 2021, SPDJI is implementing some changes to the index methodology involving: expanding the eligible universe, employing exclusion criteria and refining the carbon intensity screen.

VanEck considers the changes are not adverse and are in investors' best interests.

As a result, effective market open on 18 October 2021, the information in the **PDS** dated 24 February 2021 in **Section 8.1 – Summary of Index methodology** is updated in accordance with the information accessible at https://www.spglobal.com/spdji/en/indices/esg/sp-global-clean-energy-select-index/.
