CLARIFICATION ANNOUNCEMENT

Regional Express Holdings Limited (Rex) refers to the announcement titled "Rex's Profit Guidance Following Sterling Start to New FY" dated 2 August 2022. Rex has noted reporting errors by the Media and would like to provide the following clarification:

- Rex Jet operations (referred as domestic in the announcement) recorded a pre-audited base passenger revenue of \$13.6m for July 2022;
- Rex Saab operations (referred as regional in the announcement) recorded a pre-audited base passenger revenue of \$17.9m for July 2022, almost identical to that of July 2019;
- Rex Airlines recorded a pre-audited base passenger revenue of \$31.5m in July 2022.

This announcement is authorised by Mr Richard Kwan, Company Secretary, Regional Express Holdings Limited.

Rex is Australia's largest independent regional and domestic airline operating a fleet of 60 Saab 340 and six Boeing 737-800NG aircraft to 61 destinations throughout all states in Australia. In addition to the airline Rex, the Rex Group comprises wholly owned subsidiaries Pel-Air Aviation (air freight, aeromedical and charter operator) and the two pilot academies, Australian Airline Pilot Academy in Wagga Wagga and Ballarat.
