MEDIA STATEMENT

20 October 2023

A Cessna Caravan operated by Skydive Australia has undertaken a forced landing at around 8.00am this morning at Barwon Heads Airport in Victoria.

The plane was carrying one pilot and 16 solo sports jumpers - who were planning to skydive this morning.

The pilot, who is fully licensed and trained on type, followed all appropriate aviation procedures and made the decision to put the aircraft down in a location that would ensure everyone's safety.

All on board were able to leave the plane unassisted. Emergency services arrived quickly at the scene. Seven passengers have been taken to hospital for observation.

The safety of our guests and team is our highest priority. A full investigation will be conducted to determine the cause of the incident and the company will work with all appropriate authorities.
