Gallery in production

A brief shut down at the Gallery Gold Limited Mupane gold plant in Botswana (reported to ASX on November 1, 2004) has allowed the Company to resolve a power supply problem with the SAG mill.

Managing Director Hamish Bohannan said today that the CIL plant was now fully on stream – and that the first gold had been poured last Friday.

"Gallery expects to produce more than 100,000 ounces of gold a year at an average cash cost of \$210 an ounce from Mupane – the first of the Company's African gold projects. We are also enjoying outstanding success with our drilling programs in Tanzania, where we anticipate moving ahead with a second gold project in the near future."
