RESUMPTION IN RC DRILLING PROGRAM, WONGAN HILLS, WESTERN AUSTRALIA.

Red River Resources Limited wishes to announce that it will resume its Reverse Circulation (RC) drilling program at Wongan Hills, Western Australia during the week ending Friday 28 October. Drilling is designed to test a number of highly promising soil gold and copper anomalies inferred to occur at granite/amphibolite (metabasalt) contact zones as well as in shear zones along strike.

In early November, the company has also scheduled a diamond drill rig to arrive and extend many of the RC holes with diamond drill hole tails. By doing so, the company aims to test valid structural targets at depth.

All the current planned drill holes will be sited from cleared paddocks. The project area encompasses remnant native vegetation areas with a highly diverse flora. In keeping with good environmental practice, a Rare Flora Survey will be undertaken preparatory to any Clearing Permit applications should drilling be required away from farm paddocks.

The information within this report as it relates to geology and mineral resources was compiled by the Managing Director Mr John Karajas. Mr Karajas is a Member of the Australian Institute of Geoscientists. Mr. Karajas has sufficient experience which is relevant to the style of mineralization and the type of deposit under consideration to qualify as a Competent Person as defined in the 2004 Edition of the "Australasian Code for Reporting of Exploration Results, Mineral Resources and Ore Reserves, the JORC Code".
