Section 249D Notice

January 30, 2024: Harvest Technology Group Limited (ASX:HTG) (**Company, Harvest, Group**) advises that in accordance with ASX Listing Rule 3.17A, the Company has received a request from PJG Holdings (WA) Pty Ltd, Mr Paul Joseph Guilfoyle, and Mrs Julie Alice Guilfoyle being shareholders claiming to hold at least 5% of the shares in the Company, for the Company to call a general meeting of shareholders pursuant to section 249D of the Corporations Act 2001 (Cth) (Corporations Act) ("s249D Notice").

The s249D Notice was received by the Company at 3:21pm WST on Monday 29 January 2024. The s249D Notice requests the convening of a general meeting of the Company. It proposes resolutions for the removal of two (2) directors of the Company, being Mr Jeffery Sengelman, and Mr Ross McKinnon. In addition, it proposes resolutions for the appointment of two (2) directors to the Company, being Mr Paul Guilfoyle, and Mr Robert Daw.

The Company will consider the Request and comply with its obligations under the Corporations Act. If it considers the Request to be valid for the purposes of s249D of the Corporations Act, the Company will undertake the necessary steps to convene a general meeting in compliance with the Corporations Act.

Further details of any general meeting, if required, will be circulated in due course.
