## ARAFURA FURTHER STRENGTHENS BOARD WITH KEY APPOINTMENTS

**Arafura Rare Earths Limited (ASX: ARU)** ("Arafura" or the "Company") is pleased to announce the appointment of **Dr Roger Higgins** and **Mr Michael Spreadborough** to its Board as Independent Non-Executive Directors, effective 8 April 2024.

Dr Higgins brings more than 50 years of global experience in the resources industry. He has a degree in Civil Engineering from The University of Queensland, an MSc from the University of Aberdeen and a PhD from the University of NSW. Dr Higgins has held senior executive roles with BHP and Teck. He is currently a non-executive director of Worley and Hillgrove Resources, and previously of Newcrest, Ok Tedi Mining and Demetallica. Mr Spreadborough is a senior corporate mining executive with more 30 years of leadership experience in the mining and resources industry, including at Rio Tinto, WMC (Olympic Dam), Sandfire Resources and MetalsX. He has worked across the entire value chain, from exploration through to port operations, and has held senior executive roles at operational, corporate and board level. Mr Spreadborough has a B.Eng (Mining) from the University of Queensland and an MBA from Deakin University. Mr Spreadborough is currently Executive Co-Chairman of Novo Resources Group.
