EXPANDED DRILL PROGRAM AND FIRST SAMPLES DESPATCHED AT DANTE

Highlights:

- 17 drillholes have been completed at the Dante copper, gold and platinum group element ("PGE") project for a total of approximately 3,600 metres as part of the maiden reverse circulation ("RC") drill program.
- All 17 completed holes have been despatched to the laboratory for assay. Approximately 30 more RC drillholes are planned across the 4 priority prospects.
- Based on initial visual observations, the drill program has now been expanded from a planned 30 drillholes to approximately 47 drillholes.
- Drilling commenced at the Cronus magmatic copper-gold sulphide target before moving to the Crius copper, gold, PGE reef.
- Next, the drill rig will move to the Hyperion copper, gold, PGE reef, where the field team have identified a new gossan near planned drilling. This will be followed by the Oceanus copper, gold, PGE reef.

GCX Managing Director and CEO Thomas Line commented: "Despite heavy seasonal rains temporarily impacting logistics, we are very pleased with the progress of the maiden RC drilling program at the Dante project. We are testing a series of hypotheses regarding the nature of mineralisation at Dante, and our initial observations are providing confidence in our models. We look forward to releasing the first lot of assays, which will make up only a small portion of the total program. Shareholders can expect strong news flow and many assay results over the coming months".




Figure 1. Priority prospects at the Dante Project including the 4 priority drill targets Cronus, Hyperion, Crius and Oceanus.




Figure 2. Initial focus area at Dante Project, showing the Cronus Ni-Cu-PGE prospect and high-grade PGE reefs.




Figure 3. Dante Project location map displaying surrounding companies' tenure and major deposits.
